



Wrexham Hosts North Wales Masters Open 2019

Renewing on-court rivalries and reacquainting with old friends, Welsh squash's stalwarts spanning ages from 35-75 made their way to Wrexham for the chance of silverware at the North Wales Masters Open 2019.

In the first of six playing categories that competed from March 23-24, Carla Lauder took home the ladies' title, beating Janet Coleman (15/10, 15/13, 15/5); while Lynne Davies claimed third place.

In the men's over 35/40 competition, Jon Davies overcame Gareth Frost in the final (11/6, 11/7, 11/9) after both had topped their respective pools; Scott Roberts pipping Ben Lauder to bronze.

Darren Lee proved too strong for Dan Aimer in the men's over 45/50 showpiece (11/6, 11/7, 11/3), with Eddie Filan coming third; while Alan Coppack triumphed in a show-stopping over 55 final against Gareth Williams (9/11, 12/10, 11/4, 9/11, 11/7); as Kevin Jones beat Steve Bell in the third-place play-off.

Mark Davies was the best of the bunch in the over 60/65s, topping a pool that also contained Kevin Lloyd and Paul McDonald; while Duncan Jones finished top of the table in the over 70/75s.
