Safeguarding Update

WSRB is committed to creating and maintaining the safest possible environment for children and young people.



We do this by:

Recognising that all children have the right to freedom from abuse.

Ensuring that all our volunteers and staff are carefully selected and accept responsibility for helping to prevent the abuse of children in their care.

Responding swiftly and appropriately to all suspicions or allegations of abuse, and providing parents and children with the opportunity to voice any concerns they may have.

Appointing a Child Welfare Officer who will take specific responsibility for child protection and act as a main point of contact for parents, children and outside agencies.

Ensuring access to confidential information is restricted to the Child Welfare Officer or the appropriate external authorities.

Reviewing the effectiveness of our Safeguarding and Protecting Children Policy and activities on an annual basis.

WSRB focus on a Child Centred Approach 2016/2017 season

Use of existing Leadership Academy students to support and influence the development of safeguarding resources. Children are provided with leadership opportunities and mechanisms to enable them to lead and initiate action.

Communication and consultation with children is integrated into project and organisational action plans and strategies.

Projects that encourage young people to become involved. i.e. young leaders awards and ambassador programme.

Opportunity for disabled young people to produce their own personal development plan, training and volunteering opportunities at regional and national events

Young people’s input into the design and development for new events and projects
