



ADULT RANKING SYSTEM

The Adult ranking system is provided by Horizon.

It is based purely on 'head to head' results i.e. the results of matches against other players.

As with all ranking systems the points are calculated on a rolling 12 months basis with only results obtained in the previous 12 months counting.

Players are allocated a starting value when entered into the system and this has been calculated depending on where in our league structure the player is competing; South Wales League or County League and in which division of the relevant league they play.

All league results are taken into account and also results obtained in sanctioned tournaments. Dates for tournaments can be found on the Wales Squash & Racketball website.

Tournaments are graded as follows:

Grade 1 – WSRB sanctioned National & European tournaments e.g. Welsh Closed, Welsh Open, North Wales Open, Coors Open.

Grade 2 – WSRB sanctioned regional tournaments e.g. all other tournaments such as County Closed tournaments, Overage tournaments.

Points are added/subtracted from players' total points depending on the results of individual matches. The points added/subtracted will vary depending on the points value of the opponent i.e. more points will be gained from beating a higher ranked player than for beating a lower ranked player.

Whenever possible the rankings will be updated at the start of each calendar month and starting points reviewed periodically.
