Matters arising

There were no matters arising that were not agenda items.

League dates for Winter 2017/Spring 2018 seasons

The meeting were provided with printed sheets outlining dates for the Winter 2018 and Spring 2019 seasons.

Matters for discussion

1. League feedback – two requests for feedback in relation to the League Master software and squashlevels ranking system had been sent and very little feedback had been received. The feedback received had been positive. One team captain had commented on the travelling involved in Premier 2 which the League Manager had circulated to all Premier 2 teams who were all satisfied with the current structure.
2. A suggested amendment to Rule 7 i.e. re-ranking playing orders during a season had been previously circulated. A short discussion took place and questions regarding 'new' players and 'injured' players were clarified. The meeting voted 13 for 0 against with 4 abstained. The new rule will be introduced for the Winter 2018 season. A rule amendment regarding the method of recording referees for claiming referee points had also been previously circulated. This did not require a vote, the meeting accepted it was good practice to amend the rule.
